The Second Rewrite Cancer Innovation Challenge

Recent advances in testing and genomic profiling have started to improve the way patients and physicians can identify the optimal treatment path based on specific tumour biomarkers. However, access to the right testing at the right time can vary by geography. How do we improve awareness and availability of testing in community care and rural settings to ensure patients receive the most appropriate treatment for their cancer?

- The steering committee will review and answer all questions submitted.
- Questions and answers will then be compiled and shared with all registered teams on March 5, 2019
